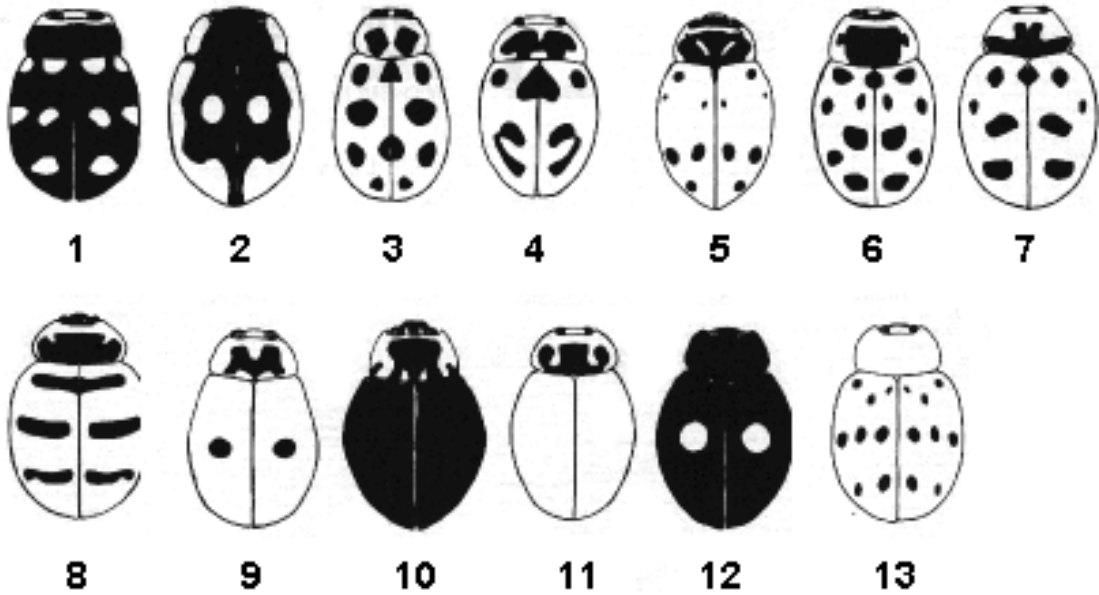


LADYBUG IDENTIFICATION



1. *Brachyacantha ursina* 3.0-4.0 mm.
2. *Hyperaspis undulata* 2.0-2.5 mm.
3. *Coleomegilla maculata lengi* spotted lady beetle, 5.0-7.0 mm.
4. *Hippodamia parenthesis* lady beetle, 4.0-5.0 mm.
5. *Hippodamia convergens* Convergent lady beetle, 6.0-7.0 mm.
6. *Hippodamia tredecimpunctata* thirteenspotted lady beetle, 4.5-5.5 mm
7. *Coccinella novemnotata* ninespotted lady beetle, 5.5-7.0 mm.
8. *Coccinella trifasciata* 4.5-5.0 mm.
9. *Adalia bipunctata* two-spotted lady beetle, 4.0-5.0 mm.
10. *Anatis quindecimpunctata* fiftenspotted lady beetle, 7.0-10.0 mm.
11. *Cycloneda munda* 4.0-5.5 mm.
12. *Chilocorus stigma* twice-stabbed lady beetle, 4.0-5.0 mm.
13. *Epilachna varivestis* Mexican bean beetle, 6.0-9.0 mm.
