
## What is a wetland?

Wetlands come in many shapes and sizes. Different types of wetlands have different functions in an ecosystem.



Three things wetlands have in common

- 1. Water (surface or ground)
- 2. Wetland soil (formed with water called hydric)
- 3. Wetland plants (plants that can be submerged)
