Air masses are named for their source: Tropical (T), Polar (P), Arctic (colder than Polar) (A), Equatorial (E).

Moisture is represented by: Continental (c) and Marine (m). EXAMPLES: Air formed over the Tropical Ocean = mT; Air that is cold, dry, continental = cP
