





Plops into the water.






Move 3 coins to make the triangle face the opposite direction.




Patterns of coins




Remove 3 coins to make the 6 equal squares into 3 equal squares.




Circle game

Predicting Paths


We roll a wheel along a flat surface.


Draw the shape that would be traced.
